2. Information

David Banks informed about the French Association of Systemic Functional Linguistics, which is going to carry out an introduction to SFL for PhD students and is preparing a Special Issue of Linguistics and the Human Sciences with selected papers from the conference in Paris.

The Chair informed about the Geoff Thompson bursary, which implies a waiver of conference registration fees and gala dinner for the recipient of the bursary. The recipient of the bursary for this year has been Anastasiia Piroh, a PhD student of English Studies at the University of Duisburg-Essen, in Germany.

3. Change of ESFLA Committee positions

The Association Chair informs that Alexandra Holsting, chair of the previous ESFLC in Denmark will no longer be an ex-officio member of the ESFLA Committee. Her position, as past Conference Chair, will be occupied by Ana Elina Martinez-Insua, the present Conference Chair, soon after 32ESFLC. Claudia Stoian, chair of ESFLC33, in Timisoara, Romania will be the new ex-officio member of the Committee.

Sheena Gardner is no longer Assistant Treasurer, UK, of the association. Gail Forey has accepted to be the new Assistant Treasurer, UK.

4. Treasurer's report

The treasurer informed that there has not been much movement to report on. The Report of accounts in Annex 1 was shown and approved.

Finally, the Assembly was informed that the Committee has decided to donate around 15% of the ESFLA savings (£700) to the Halliday and Hasan archive project.
